How much time does this require?

We use ZOOM video conferencing for our Executive Committee Meetings (6/year) and for half of our Full Board Meetings (6/year). Meetings are typically 1.5 hours. Full board physical meetings will only take place 3 times per year, plus a full-day strategic planning session. Committee participation is encouraged. Our committees include: Executive, Personnel, Policy, Finance, and Board Membership. On average, you should expect a time commitment of no more than 6 hours per month.
